ANNOUNCE A NEW CO-SPONSOR FOR HR 1565**

Colorado Mothers Stand with Congressman Jared Polis

(Denver, CO) Nov. 27, 2013– Today Moms Demand Action for Gun Sense in America announced that Representative Jared Polis has co-sponsored the King-Thompson bill (HR 1565).

Members of Moms Demand Action met with Colorado Rep. Polis' staff on the nine month anniversary of the Newtown shooting. Before the one year anniversary, Polis has co-sponsored HR 1565, a bi-partisan bill that will expand background checks to all commercial firearm purchases. A similar bill in Colorado is already working. According to a recent report released by the Colorado Bureau of Investigations, 98% of background checks were effective with an average wait time of three minutes.

“This is a no-brainer bill that will save lives,” said Jennifer Hope, Colo. chapter leader for Moms Demand Action for Gun Sense in America. “We need our elected officials to know that their ‘D’ or ‘F’ rating from the NRA should be a badge of honor. We have their backs and they can count on us to support them as long as they support the safety of our children. We are grateful to Rep. Polis for co-signing this common-sense bill.”
